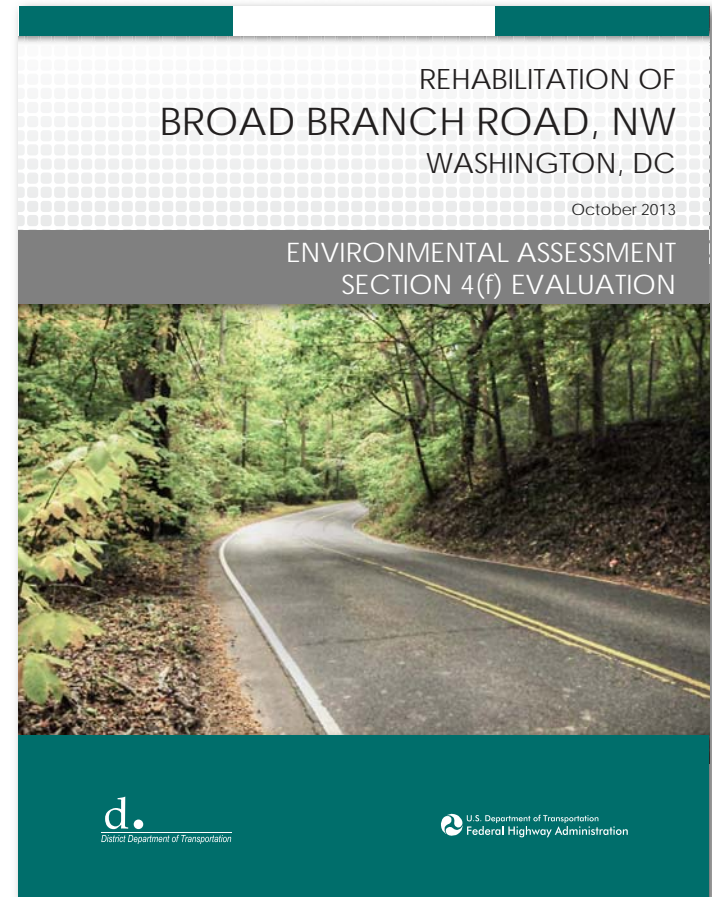


TONIGHT'S PUBLIC HEARING
